# **Agreement on Cooperation**

Turība University (hereinafter — Turiba) in the presence of the Rector Aldis Baumanis in accordance with the constitution of the University on the one hand and National University of Food Technologies (hereinafter — NUFT) in the presence of the Rector Anatoliy Ukrainets in accordance with the University statute on the other hand (hereinafter referred to as Parties) have concluded the present contract as follows:

## 1. Subject of the contract

- 1.1. The Parties hereby undertake to cooperate in the field of scientific and research development by participating jointly in scientific projects and jointly organizing practical scientific conferences.
- 1.2. The Parties undertake to provide students the opportunity of obtaining international education, promote mobility for academic staff by involving members of academic staff of the other Party as guest lecturers in programmes on parity principles.
- 1.3. Turiba undertakes in accordance with mutual agreement with the NUFT to train and provide the NUFT's students the opportunity to study Bachelor or Master study modules at Turiba for duration of one semester.
- 1.4. NUFT undertakes in accordance with mutual agreement with Turiba to train and provide the Turiba's students the opportunity to study Bachelor and Master study modules at NUFT for duration of one semester

### 2. Cooperation in scientific development

- 2.1. The Parties hereby undertake to inform each other on the scientific and scientific practical conferences that are being organised.
- 2.2. Parties undertake to consider the invitations of the other Party for participation in the organisation of the international conferences and their involvement in the conferences within reasonable grounds.
- 2.3. Transport, accommodation and living expenses for the representatives of the Parties in jointly organised conferences shall be borne by the respective Parties themselves.
- 2.4. Parties undertake in accordance with their academic and financial capabilities to involve each other in joint scientific research and financial grants.

#### 3. Mobility of academic staff

- 3.1. Parties undertake to inform each other on the possibility of involvement of academic staff of the other Party in the provision of the study programmes.
- 3.2. Parties undertake to cover the transport, accommodation and living expenses of their respective academic staff that have been chosen for guest lectures.
- 3.3. Academic staff that is guest lecturers in the partner institution shall not receive any additional remuneration from the partner institution.

## 4. Studies of University and Turiba students at the partner institution

- 4.1. Parties shall each year before the 15<sup>th</sup> of May agree upon the study modules that would be available for students of both institutions at Turiba and University.
- 4.2. The language of instruction of study modules shall be English.
- 4.3. Parties undertake to transfer the credit points obtained to students who have successfully completed the study module and shall upon successful completion issue students a certificate.
- 4.4. Host institution shall provide students who have arrived for studies in accordance with the study contract for the study module mentioned in clause 4.1 with accommodation in the Turiba's or University's student hostel that are available for the institutions' students. However, the Parties agree that the students shall cover their accommodation expenses at the student hostel and living expenses themselves.

#### 5. Other Conditions

- 5.1. The present contract comes into force from the moment of signing by the Parties and is valid for 5 years.
- 5.2. The parties undertake to resolve any disputes or differences that may arise in connection with the present contract by mutual agreement between the Parties. In case the Parties shall not come to an agreement within 3 (three) months of commencement of the resolution of the aforesaid disputes the same shall be resolved by the Court in the country of the Party that is the defendant in the dispute.
- 5.3. The present contract is drafted in 2 (two) copies in English each on 2 (two) pages. One copy is foreseen for Turiba and the other for the University.
