

MEMORANDUM OF SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION
between
NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF FOOD TECHNOLOGIES,

and
CHINA NATIONAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF FOOD AND FERMENTATION
INDUSTRIES, BEIJING CHIN

National University of Food Technologies (hereafter referred to as NUFT), 68, Volodymyrska Str., Kyiv, Ukraine, 01601, represented by Pro-Rector for Research of the University, Doctor of Technical Sciences, Professor, Schevchenko Oleksandr Yuhymovych, duly entitled to sign, on the one part,

and

China National Research Institute of Food and Fermentation Industries, (hereafter referred to as CNRIFFI), N0:24-6, Jiuxianqiao zhonglu, Chaoyang district, Beijing China, represented for the purpose of signing this agreement Prof Zhang Wujiu, Vice president of CNRIFFI duly entitled to sign, on the other part,

(Hereafter jointly referred to as "the Participants")

The Participants hereby affirm their mutual interest in the cooperative research. After friendly discussion aimed at the promotion of further scientific and technological cooperation focusing on the problems listed in Article 1 and taking into account that these problems present a major interest and significance for both countries, the Participants have reached an agreement as follows:

Article 1
FIELDS OF COOPERATION

1.1. The field of cooperation to be developed within this Memorandum will encompass the following scientific problem:

1.1.1. Adsorptive purification of drinking water and alcohol solutions by modified adsorbents.

1.2. Participants to this Memorandum have reached an agreement that mentioned above problem is extremely important. The parties also mark that solving of the problems set above may contribute significantly to the quality and safety of food products as well as they will allow lowering energy and resource consumption within the food manufacturing process.

Article 2
SCOPE OF COOPERATION

2.1. To facilitate the cooperative research efforts, each Participant intends to assign such members of its staff to specific projects as may be mutually agreed upon, as well as aid in planning and developing projects of mutual interest.

2.2. When agreed between the Participants, they will have personnel exchange, including visiting professors and research fellows, and receiving undergraduate and graduate students from the partner during periods of study and/or research.

2.3. Funds required for the implementation of this Memorandum will be determined on the basis of individual projects through joint application intergovernmental project, and the Participants will try to obtain outside funding to implement this agreement effectively.

2.4. This Memorandum does not constitute a financial obligation to serve as a basis for expenditures. Each Participant will handle and expend its own funds. All expenditures of each Participant will be according to its own governing rules and regulations.

Article 3
GENERAL PROVISIONS

3.1. The details of future cooperative undertakings may be planned and executed under the auspices of separate Memorandum between the Participants.

3.2. The term of validity of the agreement is from 3rd July 2019 to 3rd July 2021. It may be extended by mutual agreement of the Participants.

3.3. This agreement may be modified only by mutual Memorandum between the Participants in writing, and may be discontinued at the request of either Participant. Termination requests shall be sent to the other Participant not less than 60 calendar days prior to the desired effective date.

3.4. This Memorandum is executed in two originals, one for each Participant.
