

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE & COMPUTER (STEKOM UNIVERSITY)



NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF FOOD TECHNOLOGIES



In order to develop mutual beneficial of international cooperation and to establish strong international relations between University of Science & Computer Technology (STEKOM University) from Indonesia and National University of Food Technologies (NUFT) from Ukraine are agree to the following provisions:

I. Scope of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This MoU shall commemorate the parties' intent to enter into but not be limited to, the following types of collaborations:

- A. Academic Study and Research Opportunities
- B. Students Exchanges
- C. Short and Long-term Faculty Exchanges
- D. Delegation Visit
- E. Other mutually agreed activities or programs.

Before executing these collaborations, the involved parties will discuss the plans and challenges occurred and will thereafter enter into specific agreements.

II. Period of MOU

This MoU shall be effective upon the date of the latest signature and will remain valid for a period of five (5) years, after which the institutions may mutually agree to extend the agreement. Either institutions may terminate the agreement by providing a written notice to the other party six (6) months prior to termination.

III. **Activities Under This MOU**

All activities undertaken must conform to the policies and procedure in place at each institution. Each distinct collaboration program or activity will be described in a separate Activity MoU and authorized by each party. The ongoing agreements or activities shall not be effected by one of the party's termination.

IV. **Funding of Activities**

The activity agreement financial costs and obligations should be transparent. Both institutions may provide the funding or in other option should work together to identify and obtain any outside funding which may be needed. Projects requiring funding must be approved by both parties.

V. Modification

These MoU Terms may be changed or modified by written amendment signed by authorized representatives of the parties hetero.

VI. Contact Person

A designated contact person from both institutions will communicate with each other as necessary to develop specific parameter for collaboration.

VII. Non-Binding

The parties understand that Science & Computer Technology (STEKOM) University must adhere to all policies and procedures of the University, the PAT Foundation, and the Governments of this agreements. This MoU is non-binding and solely for the purpose of establishing a basis upon which STEKOM University and the National University of Food Technologies will continue discussions.
